ANIMAL INTAKE FAQs

- Intake is done by ***appointment only*** by contacting the intake coordinator or designee 928 551 1497.
- Animals may **never** be left/abandoned at the Thrift Store or the Shelter Facility. Thrift store volunteers are not allowed to do intake.
- The surrender fee for someone's own animal is 30.00 per animal and will be collected by the intake coordinator after an initial assessment is done.
- Found animals must be reported to the local animal control officer by calling Apache County dispatch at 928 337 4321, Eagar 928 333 4127 or Springerville 928 333 5746. After reporting to the proper authorities and when foster or shelter space is immediately available, RVAR may be able to provide temporary shelter for found animals pending locating an owner.
- RVAR is only able to accept animals based upon *intake* criteria – which includes an assessment of the animal's general health, availability of either foster or shelter space, and whether the animal is potentially adoptable based upon behaviors and our insurance underwriter's requirements. Unfortunately, not all animals may be accepted automatically.
- RVAR does not provide health services or food to animals with homes/owners.
