

ROUND VALLEY ANIMAL RESCUE RESPONSIBILITIES OF FOSTERS

ALL FOSTERS:

- Must be *members in good standing of RVAR* and provide full contact information including home phone, cell phone, email address and home address.
- May not “foster” animals they have personally owned. *Note: RVAR will cooperate with owners seeking to adopt out an RVAR-approved animal, to the extent of showing the animal on the RVAR and Petfinder websites, and allowing them to attend adoption days to show their animals. RVAR will not supply food, vaccines or other funding for owned animals.*
- Must comply fully with necessary paperwork, including intake forms and adoption forms which may ONLY be completed by one of the designated intake coordinators. Animals taken in to the RVAR foster process must have been evaluated first and intake paperwork completed by a designated intake coordinator before the animal will be eligible for services through RVAR.
- Must participate *in a meaningful way* with all adoption activities including: adoption day events, timely submission of a photo and bio to webmaster@rvarescue.com for submission to the adoption pages on the RVAR website and Petfinders. Please contact 928-551-1497 if you have questions or need help with adoption day and the web activities. Failure to participate in a meaningful way results in discontinuation as a foster and the animal being considered adopted.
- Must assure that their foster animals are receiving appropriate medical services including spay/neuter and vaccinations when appropriate and in a timely manner. Services requested and obtained *must be communicated immediately* to 928-551-1497 for accurate record-keeping purposes.

Fosters who have fully complied with the above are eligible for:

- Veterinary services paid for by RVAR including vaccinations, treatments and spay/neuter services.
- Assistance with all necessary paperwork, photos, bios and advertising the animal for adoption.
- Shelter and feed when deemed necessary.

RVAR considers the foster role as a very important one and is grateful for the excellent service many have provided. Fosters who fail to comply with the above requirements will be discontinued as fosters and their fostered animal will be considered adopted.
